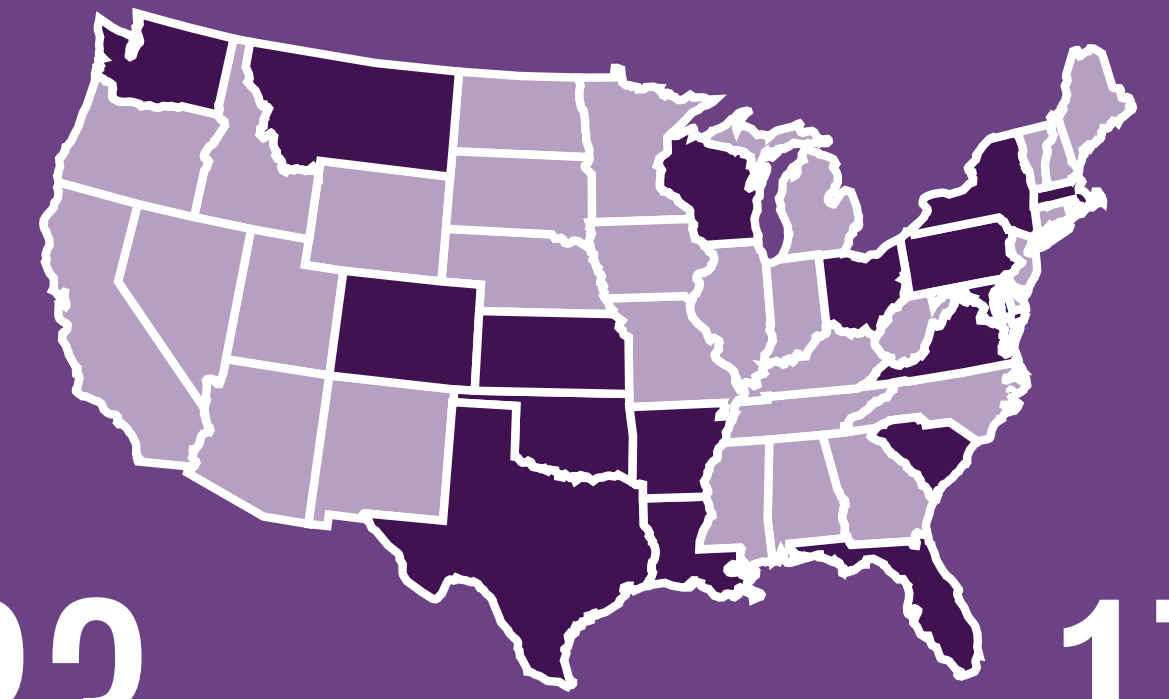

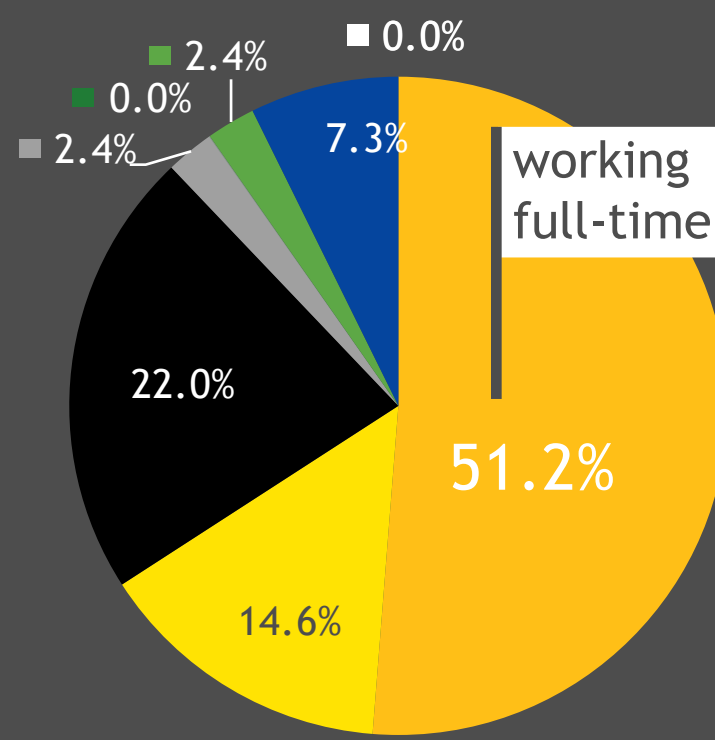

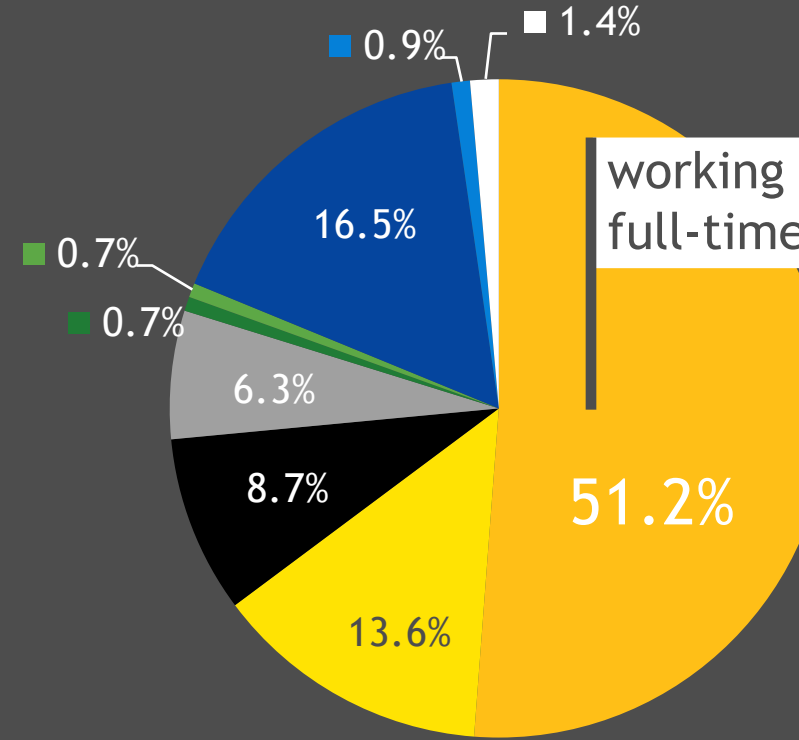

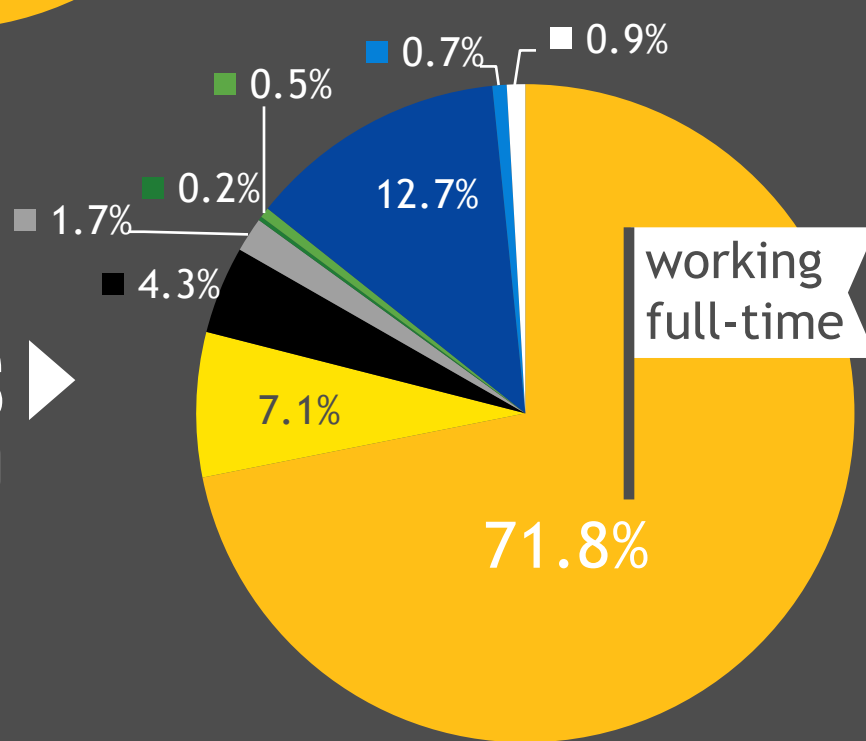

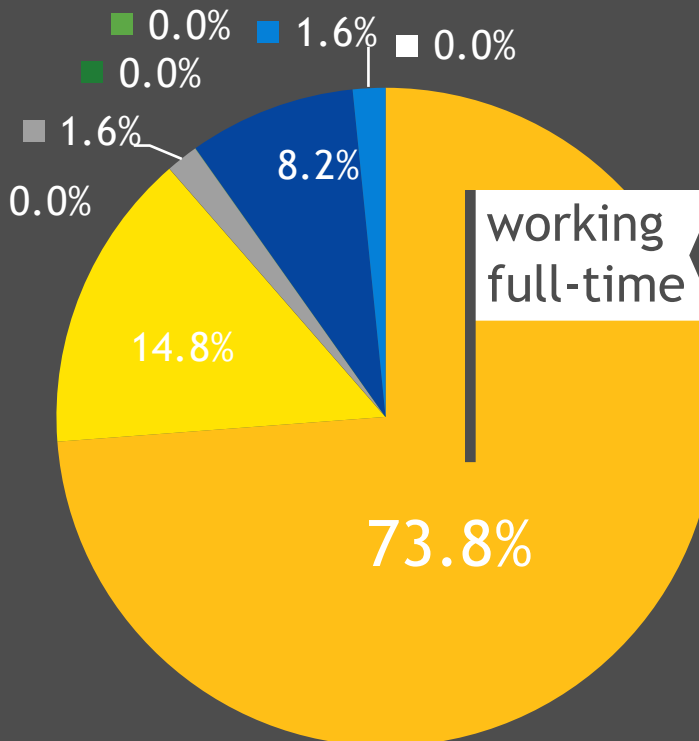

Primary Status by Degree Level

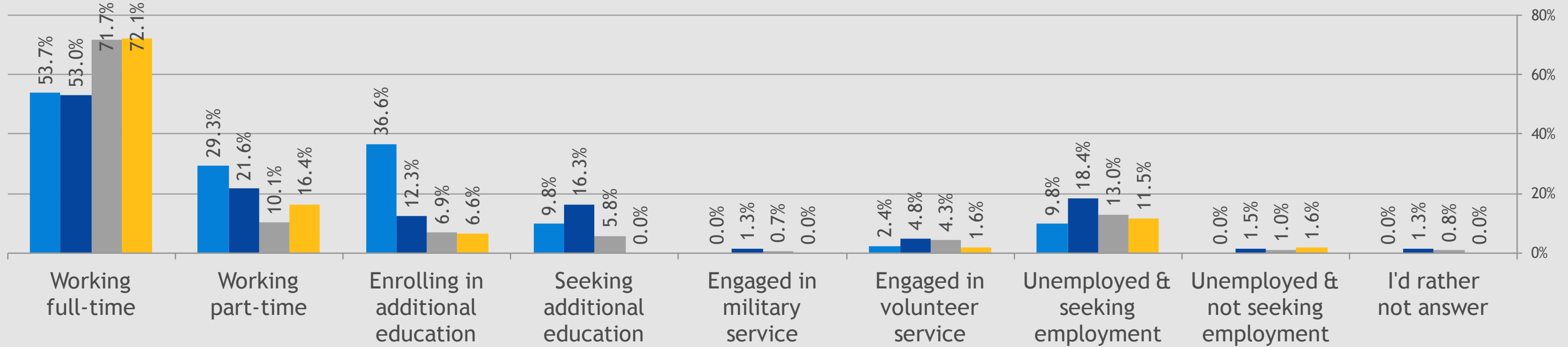

Multiple Status by Degree Level



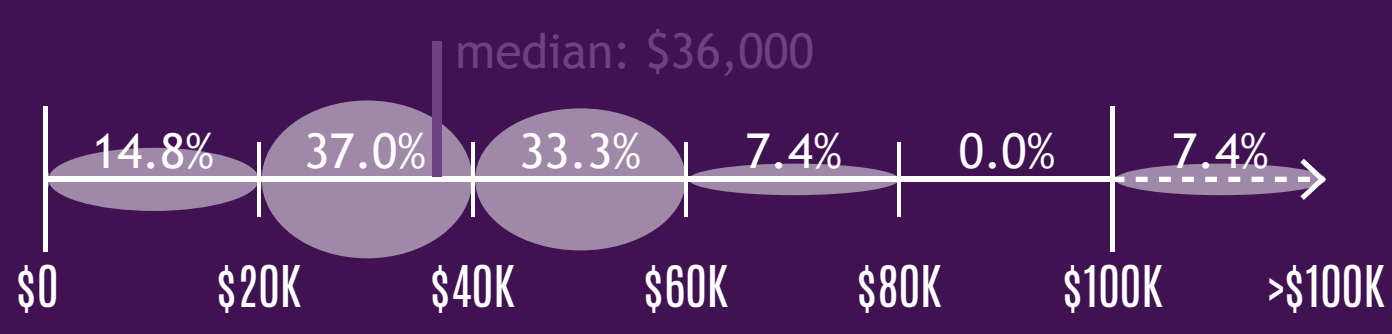

Average Income by Degree Level*

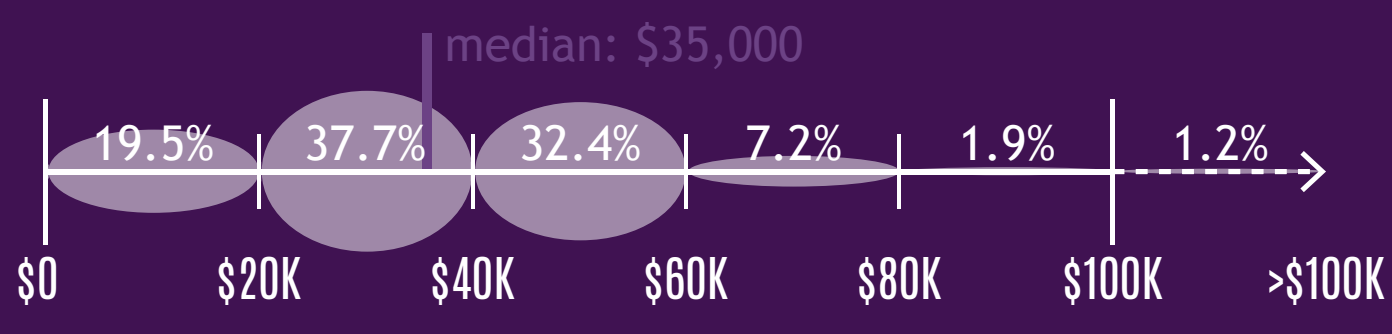

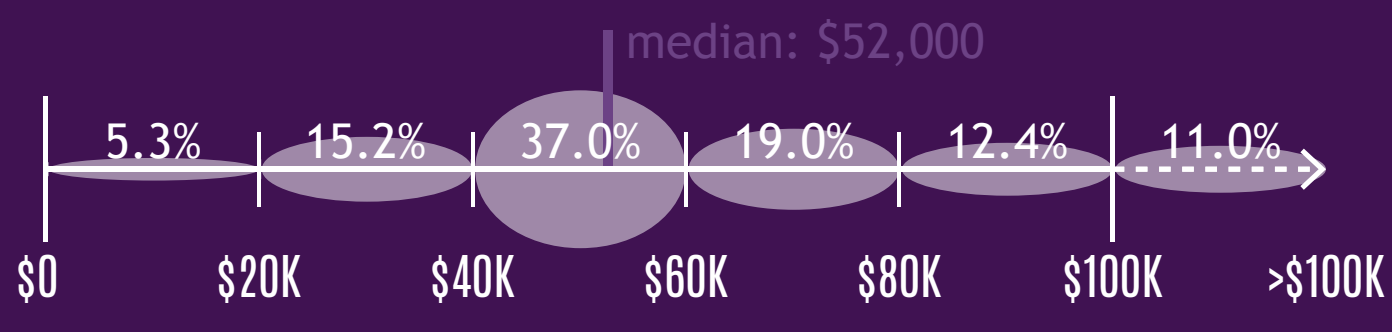

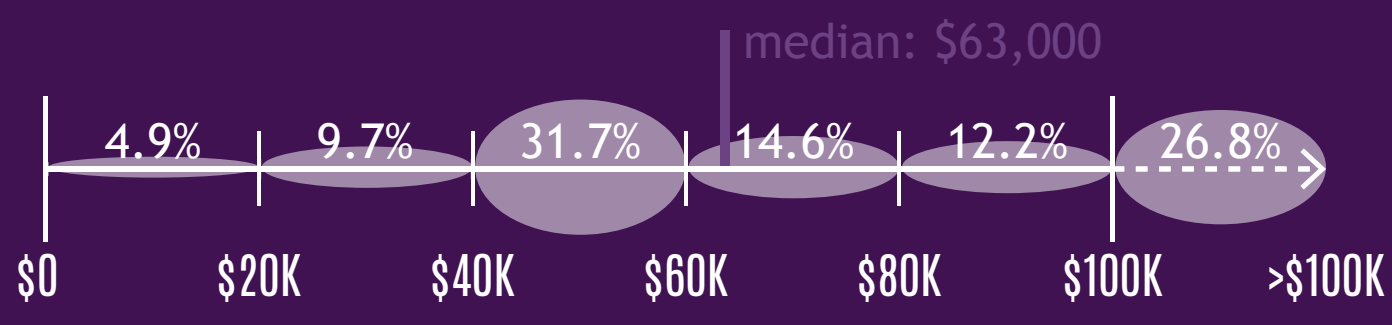

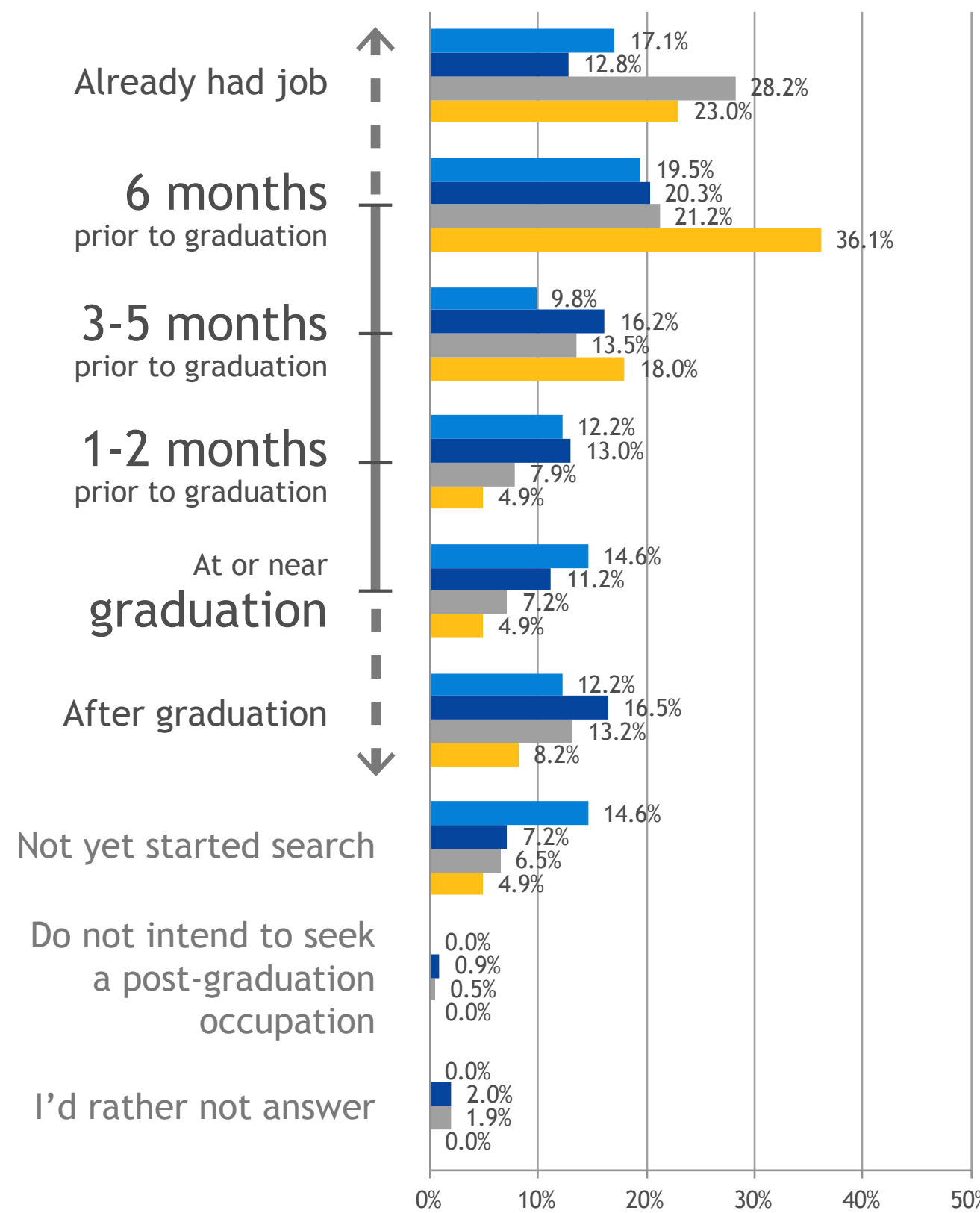

Occupation Search Start Date



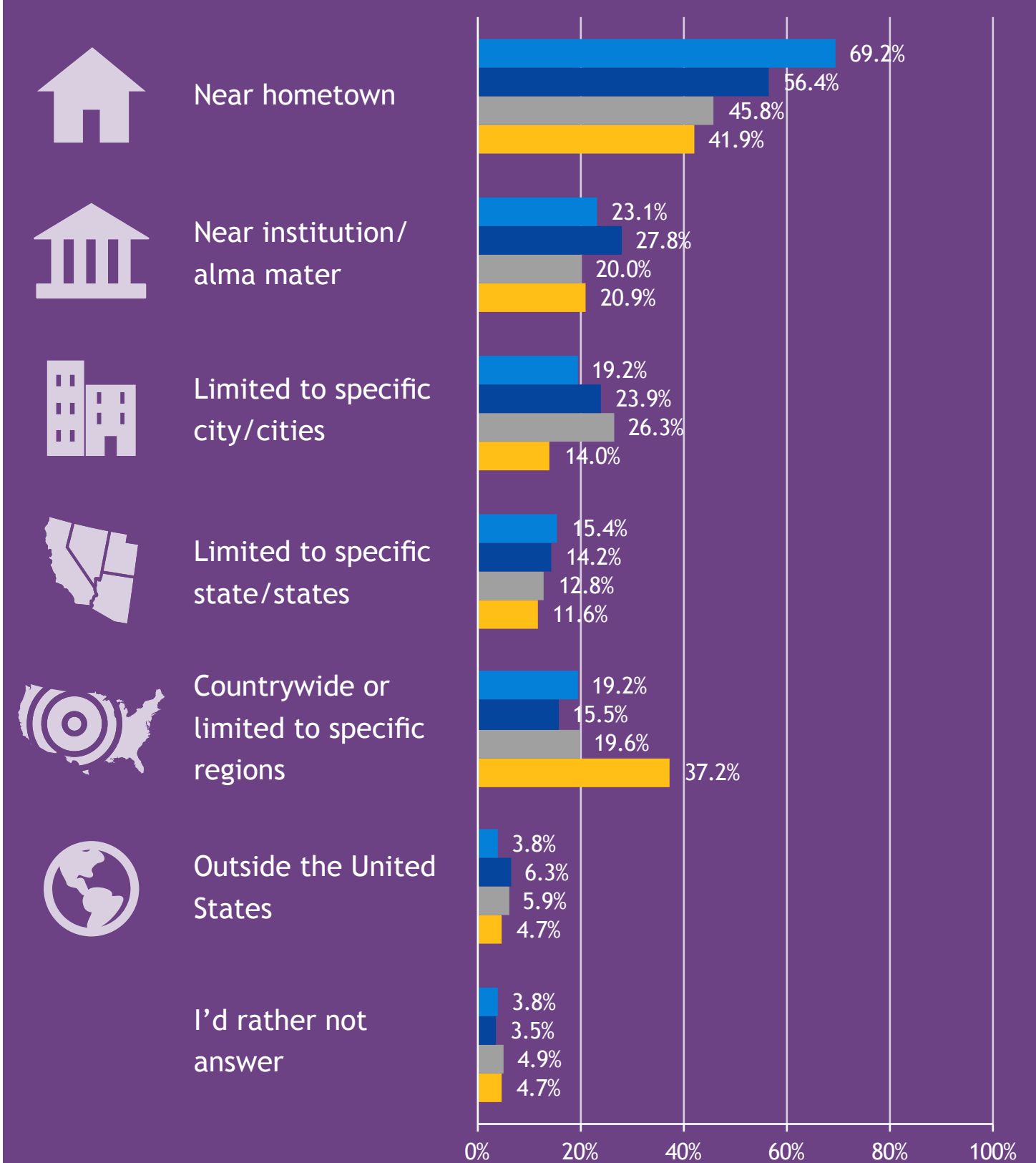
