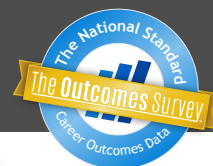
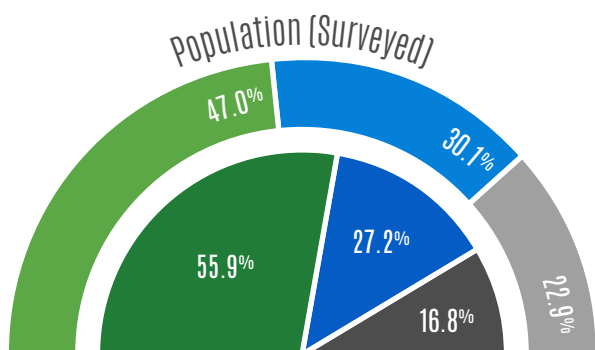

GENDER

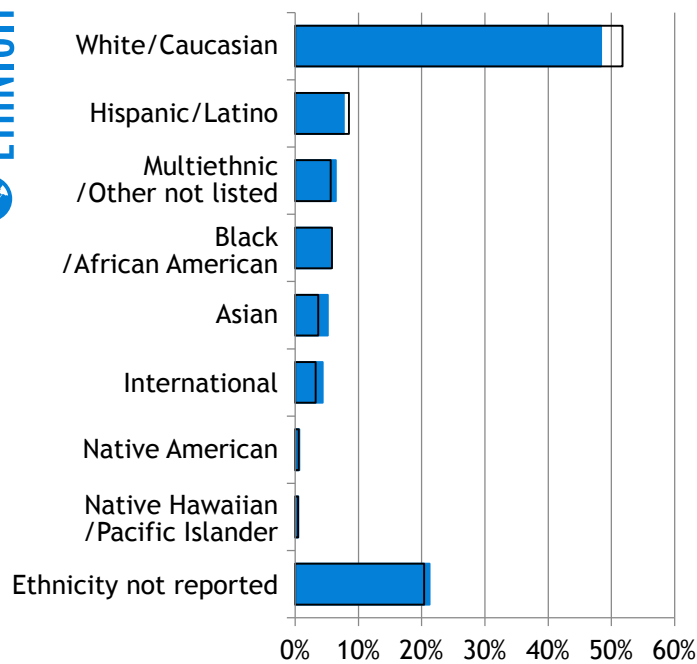

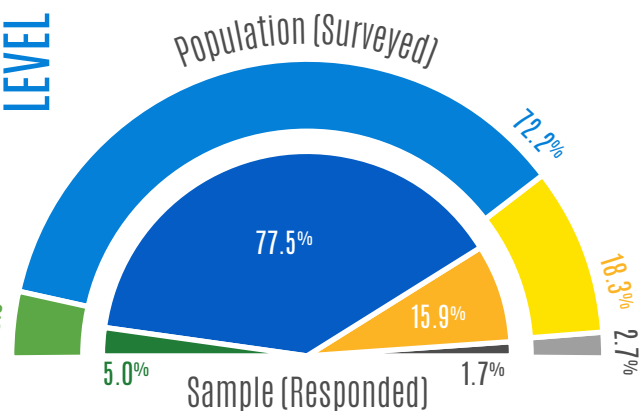

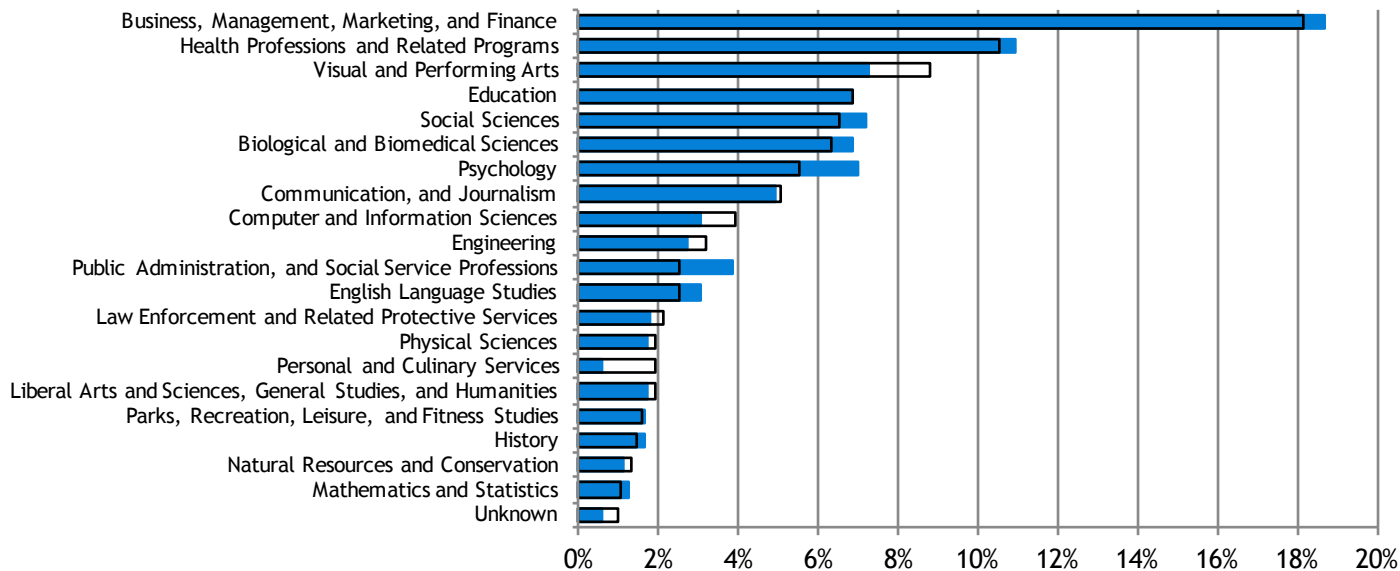

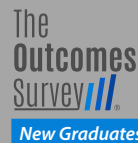
Data Disclaimer: Those schools using The Outcomes Survey® during the IPEDS 2014-2015 academic year to gather career outcomes data according to the standardized schedules and procedures prescribed by the Gold Standard are included in these data. For data standards information and disclaimers, go to TheOutcomesSurvey.com/DataStandards. Chi-square tests of goodness-of-fit were performed to determine whether the demographic proportions of survey respondents differed from those proportions of the student population. No significant differences were identified. Statistics are reported below.

GENDER: $\chi^2 (2, n=100) = 3.59, p > .10$

DEGREE LEVEL: $\chi^2 (3, n=121) = 1.94, p > .10$

ETHNICITY: Based on modified categorizations from the US Census Bureau. $\chi^2 (8, n=167) = 2.0, p > .975$

ACADEMIC MAJORS: Based on modified IPEDS CIP classification codes. $\chi^2 (34, n=287) = 10.79, p > .995$
